ORDINANCE NO. 61

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GOLF, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE FOR THE VILLAGE OF GOLF FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING ON OCTOBER 1, 2002 AND ENDING ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2003; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within the Village of Golf has been certified by the Palm Beach County

Property Appraiser to the Village of Golf as \$89,283,847.00; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Golf has held public hearings as required by 200.065, Florida Statues, to adopt a final millage rate for fiscal year 2002/2003.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GOLF, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The Village Council of the Village of Golf does hereby adopt its final millage rate of 6.4534 mills to be levied upon all real and tangible personal property located within the boundaries of the Village of Golf to fund expenses for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2002 and ending September 30, 2003.

Section 2: The final levy of 6.4534 mills represents a 19.05% increase over the rolled-back rate.

Section 3: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinance in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 4: Should any Section or provision of this Ordinance or any portion thereof, any paragraph, sentence or word be declared by a court of competent

jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage. Section 5: FIRST READING THIS 10th DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2002. SECOND AND FINAL READING THIS 24 DAY OF SEPLIATION PASSED AND ADOPTED THIS of DAY OF September, 2002.
