ORDINANCE NO. 71

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF GOLF, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 54. AT SECTION 10.041 VARIANCES. BY REPEALING SUBSECTION (C), NOTICE REQUIREMENTS, IN ITS ENTIRETY AND READOPTING SUBSECTION (C) TO PROVIDE FOR REVISED NOTICE REQUIREMENTS TO ALL PROPERTY OWNERS WITHIN A 500 FOOT RADIUS OF THE AFFECTED PROPERTY AND TO DELETE THE REQUIREMENT THAT SUCH NOTICES BE PLACED IN A NEWSPAPER; PROVIDING THAT EACH AND EVERY OTHER SECTION AND SUBSECTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 54 SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT AS PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED; PROVIDING FOR A CONFLICTS CLAUSE, A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND AUTHORITY TO CODIFY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Golf, Florida has adopted land development regulations and design guidelines to preserve the unique character of this community; and,

WHEREAS, as redevelopment occurs in the Village circumstances may exist which would prevent property owners from improving their property in strict compliance with said regulations, although said improvements may be in keeping with the character and scale of the Village; and,

WHEREAS, the Village Council adopted certain due process procedures in order to process requests for variances in these situations and now wishes to amend these procedures while still providing for appropriate due process notices.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GOLF, FLORIDA, THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>: Ordinance No. 54 is hereby amended at Section 10.041. at Subsection (C), Notice Requirements. By repealing Subsection (C) in its entirety and readopting it with the following revised language; providing that Sec.10.041 shall hereafter read as follows:

Section 10.041. Variances

- (A) (B) (Shall remain the same as previously adopted, to include the first paragraph)
- (C) Notice Requirements. Due public notice as herein required shall be deemed sufficient when a notice is mailed via First Class Mail approximately twelve (12) days before the public hearing date to all property owners within a 500 foot radius of the boundary lines of the property for which the variance is requested. The notice shall

state the substance of the request, the time and the place for the public hearing before the Village Council. Any party may appear in person, or by agent, or by attorney at the public hearing.

Additionally, the Village Clerk shall mail a copy of said variance application to:

- 1. President of the Country Club of Florida
- 2. President of the Village of Golf Homeowners Association.

No application shall be heard less than twelve (12) days after the provision of notice to property owners directly affected as herein required, and all applications will be heard at a regular meeting of the Village Council unless otherwise ordered by the Council and duly advertised.

(D) — (E) (Shall remain the same as previously adopted.)

<u>Section 2:</u> Each and every other section and subsection of Ordinance No. 54 shall remain in full force and effect as previously adopted.

<u>Section 3</u>: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 4</u>: Should any section or provision of this Ordinance or any portion thereof, any paragraph, sentence, or word be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder hereof as a whole or part thereof other than the part to be declared invalid.

Section 5: Specific authority is given to codify this Ordinance.

Section 6: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon second reading and final passage.
