

### **ORDINANCE NO. 73**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GOLF, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE FINAL MILLAGE RATE FOR THE VILLAGE OF GOLF FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING ON OCTOBER 1, 2005 AND ENDING ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2006; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Village of Golf has held public hearings as required by 200.065, Florida Statutes, to adopt a final millage rate for fiscal year 2005/2006.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GOLF, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The Village Council of the Village of Golf does hereby adopt its final millage rate of 6.5818 mills to be levied upon all real and tangible personal property located within the boundaries of the Village of Golf to fund expenses for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2005 and ending September 30, 2006.

Section 2: The final levy of 6.5818 mills represents a 1.32% increase over the rolled-back rate of 6.4961.

Section 3: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinance in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 4: Should any Section or provision of this Ordinance or any portion thereof, any paragraph, sentence or word be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the Ordinance.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.



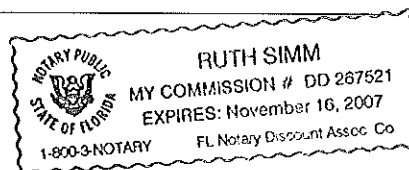
