ORDINANCE NO. 85

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GOLF, FLORIDA, REPEALING SECTION 4. TERM OF BUSINESS TAX RECEIPT. AS SET FORTH IN ORDINANCE NO. 82. THE "BUSINESS TAX RECEIPT" ORDINANCE AND READOPTING THIS SECTION IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR NEW BEGINNING SALE DATE IN COMPLIANCE WITH A RECENTLY ADOPTED LEGISLATIVE ACT, SENATE BILL 1178; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE AND A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Florida Senate Bill 1178 adopted by the Florida state legislature in 2007, effective July 1, 2007, provides that the date for beginning the annual sale of local business tax receipts be moved forward one month from August 1st to July 1st of each year; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Atlantis desires to update its business regulation code to make certain it conforms with these revisions to state law; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council believes that amending the "Business Tax Receipt" Ordinance to provide for the above-stated revisions concerning the early sale of business tax receipts in the Village is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Golf.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GOLF, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The "Business Tax Receipt" Ordinance No. 82 is hereby amended at Sec. 4. Term of Business Tax Receipt. by repealing this section and readopting it to provide for an earlier beginning sale date for business tax receipts in accordance with state law; providing that Sec. 4. of Ordinance No. 82, shall hereafter read as follows:

Sec. 4. Term of Business Tax Receipt.

All business tax receipts issued under this Ordinance shall be valid from October 1, or the date of issuance if the business tax receipt is issued thereafter, through the next succeeding September 30. No business tax receipt shall be valid for longer than one year. All business tax receipts shall be sold by the Village beginning August July 1 of each year and the business tax levied by this Ordinance and the fees set forth in this section shall be due and payable on September 30 of each year and expire on September 30 of the succeeding year. If September 30 falls on a weekend or

holiday, the business tax is due and payable on or before the first working day following September 30.

Section 2: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: Should any section or provision of this Ordinance or any portion thereof, any paragraph, sentence or word be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder hereof as a whole or any part thereof other than the part to be declared invalid.

<u>Section 4</u>: Specific authority is hereby given to codify this Ordinance.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall take effect retroactively to July 1, 2007.
