#### **ORDINANCE NO. 86**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GOLF, FLORIDA, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 46. WHICH ADOPTED A UNIFIED LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE FOR THE VILLAGE OF GOLF; ALSO REPEALING ORDINANCE NOS. 28, 48, 50, 54, 55, 56, 57, 72, 75, 80 AND 84, ALL OF WHICH PREVIOUSLY AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 46; ADOPTING A NEW SET OF LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS FOR THE VILLAGE TO BE KNOWN AS THE LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF GOLF; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE, A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND AUTHORITY TO CODIFY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Village of Golf is approaching build-out, with approximately eighty percent (80%) of the property currently developed; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Golf has developed a unique residential character over the past forty (40) years which is based on a harmonious relationship between residences and the natural environment, including the open space of the Golf Course; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council wishes to preserve the low density, small scale neighborhood and quality of life presently in existence within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council wishes to preserve the open space by minimizing the mass of single family structures and by minimizing the visual impact of any single residence in relation to the adjacent residences and in relation to the overall community, specifically the Golf Course; and

WHEREAS, while acknowledging that redevelopment will occur, the Village Council has imposed design guidelines to preserve and perpetuate the current unique character of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Golf has recently adopted its EAR based Comprehensive Plan Amendments and must now revise its Land Development Code so it will be consistent with the recently adopted Comprehensive Plan Amendments; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Golf desires to update and adopt a fully revised unified code to implement its recently adopted comprehensive plan revisions in order to comply with Chapter 163, F.S.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GOLF, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: Ordinance Nos. 28, 46, 48, 50, 54, 55, 56, 57, 72, 75, 80 and 84 are hereby repealed and the Village Council hereby adopts a new set of land development regulations which

shall be known as the Land Development Code of the Village of Golf and which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 2: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3: Should any section or provision of this Ordinance or any portion thereof, any paragraph, sentence or word be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 4: Specific authority is hereby granted to codify this Ordinance.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.
