

ORDINANCE NO. 87

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GOLF, FLORIDA, REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBERS 44 AND 60 WHICH WERE PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED RELATING TO THE UNIFORM WATER AND SEWER SERVICE POLICY AND A SCHEDULE OF RATES, FEES AND CHARGES FOR WATER AND SEWER SERVICES IN ORDER THAT THE VILLAGE COUNCIL MAY ADOPT AN UPDATED VERSION OF THE POLICY AND RATE SCHEDULE BY RESOLUTION; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE, A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND AUTHORITY TO CODIFY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Village of Golf operates a water and sewer utility system; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Golf has previously adopted and amended by ordinance the Uniform Water and Sewer Policy and a schedule of rates, fees and charges for water and sewer services; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Golf desires to repeal the necessary Village of Golf Ordinances and re-adopt an updated version of the Policy and Rate Schedule by resolution which will allow the Village Council more flexibility to amend the Uniform Water and Sewer Policy and to amend the schedule of rates, fees and charges as necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Golf believes that repealing the referenced ordinances to allow the Village Council to adopt the Uniform Water and Sewer Policy and the schedule of rates, fees and charges for water and sewer services by resolution is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Golf.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GOLF, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: Ordinance Numbers 44 and 60 are hereby repealed in their entirety including all attachments and shall be of no further force or effect.

Section 2: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: Should any section or provision of this Ordinance or any portion thereof, any paragraph, sentence or word be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid,

such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder hereof as a whole or any part thereof other than the part to be declared invalid.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.






