

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF GOLF, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, LEVYING A TAX ON REAL AND BUSINESS PERSONAL PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE FOR THE YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1971; FIXING THE MILLAGE RATE THEREOF FOR SAID YEAR, ADOPTING A FISCAL BUDGET FOR THE YEAR 1971-1972; APPROPRIATING THE VARIOUS SUMS SET OUT IN THE FISCAL BUDGET; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Be it and it is hereby ordained by the Village Council of the Village of Golf, Palm Beach County, Florida that:

Section 1. For the year ending December 31, 1971 the valuation of all real and business personal property within the Village of Golf as assessed by the Palm County Assessor is fixed as follows:

a. Non-exempt real estate	\$5,447,755
b. Personal property subject to tax	347,600
c. Homestead exempted real estate	70,000
d. Widow, disability exempted real estate	500
e. Wholly exempt real estate	64,900
Total exempt and non-exempt value	\$5,930,755

Section 2. For the year ending December 31, 1971, a tax of 10 mils on the dollar shall be, and is hereby levied and shall be collected on all real estate and business personal property within the Village of Golf, Florida, not specifically designated as homestead property, or owned by the municipality and/or expressly exempted by the laws of the constitution of the State of Florida for the purpose of raising funds for the improvements and government of the Village, and for the payment of its obligations and expenses and for the purpose of carrying out the purposes and duties granted and imposed by the Village Charter. Specifically, the 10 mil tax is apportioned as follows: 6 mils for the purpose of Water and Sewer System general obligation bonds debt service, 3 mils for the purpose of Village Security and 1 mil for General Village Services.

Section 3. The following listed items and figures shall be and same are hereby adopted as the budget for the Village of Golf, Palm Beach County, Florida for the year 1971-1972 and the various respective sums described hereafter are hereby appropriated for the purposes set out, to-wit:
