

VILLAGE OF GOLF, FLORIDA

ORDINANCE NO. 32

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF GOLF, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE PALM BEACH COUNTY OCCUPATION LICENSE ORDINANCE NO. 72-7, REGISTRATION OF SPECIFIED EMPLOYEES WITH THE VILLAGE SECURITY DEPARTMENT, VOLUNTARY SEARCH OF PRIVATE VEHICLES, THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH AND THE SEVERABILITY THEREOF.

Section 1. Occupational License. No person shall engage in or manage any business, profession or occupation in the Village of Golf for which an occupational license is required by Palm Beach County Occupational License Tax Ordinance No. 72-7 without procuring such a license. Each such person shall identify all vehicles used to transport persons, materials or equipment to the job site with identification by name or symbol in at least two locations with letters two inches or larger.

Section 2. Registration. Any person employed by the Village of Golf, by The Country Club of Florida (including caddies), by The Country Club Stables, by any lawn, pool or pest extermination service company providing regular service in the Village and any other person as may be deemed appropriate by the Chief of Security, shall register with the Security Department.

Section 3. Registration Card. A registration card shall be issued to each person registering under Section 2 of this ordinance and such registration card shall be carried by such persons at all times while within the Village limits. If such registration card shall be lost or cannot be produced, such person shall promptly re-register and secure a new card from the Security Department.

Section 4. No fee shall be charged for the issuance of a registration card and the cost thereof shall be borne by the Village.

Section 5. Voluntary Vehicle Search. A condition of registration for a person registering under Section 2 of this ordinance is the written consent of such person to submit to any search of that person's vehicle while in the geographical limits of the Village of Golf requested by the Village Manager or the Chief of Security.

Section 6. Enforcement, Violations and Penalties. The Village Council shall have the power to enforce this ordinance by the imposition of a fine for a violation. Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$100.00.

Section 7. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances and Resolutions.  
Ordinance No. 15 and all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 8. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court or competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

Section 9. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its reading, passage, approval and adoption as provided by law.
